Alamance County

Residential Plan Review Requirements

The following is provided as a guide for obtaining Building plan approval for residential single-family dwellings, modular homes, and additions and renovations in Alamance County. It applies to all plans submitted under the 2018 NC Residential code.

General

- Two sets of plans should be submitted. They must be properly collated / stapled. We give them both back to you
- Floor plan layout with all rooms / areas labeled for use
- Window and door sizes
- Site plan

Insulation

Insulation values for floors, walls and ceilings. Provide detail for monolithic slab

foundations

Structural

- Footing and foundation details
- Thickened slab details for poured concrete foundations
- Complete details for floor joists and girders for all floor systems
- Sealed floor truss plans if they are used
- Wall construction details, including stud height, size, spacing and wall bracing method / details
- We are no longer requiring **roof** truss drawings at plan review time, these should be placed in the permit box for the framing inspection. A layout is required as well
- If roof is stick framed, complete roof structural including size, spacing, direction of all members including ceiling joists and all rafters
- All header and girder sizes with bearing and attachment details and locations (For LVL headers, the plans should just state "LVL header")
- The cut sheets for each LVL header must be in the permit box at the time of framing inspection.
- Point loaded LVL headers- cut sheet must be sealed by engineer
- Any steel girders must be sized and sealed by engineer

Decks

- Dimensional plans including:
- Footings
- Post locations
- Girder and joist size, span, spacing and direction

• Fire protection - duplex, townhome, multi-family

- Separation wall design and details
- Fire separation details for soffit
